## **Estelle Pace**

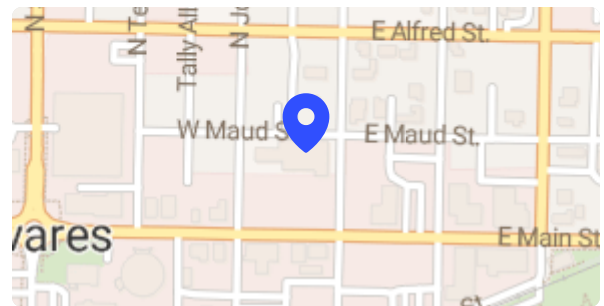

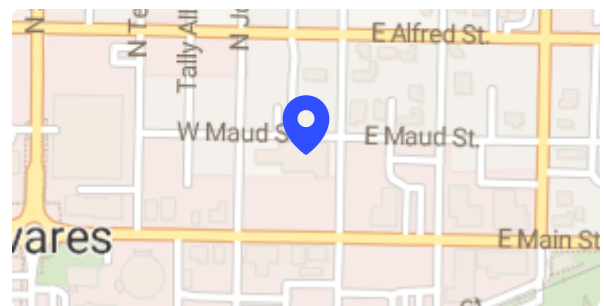

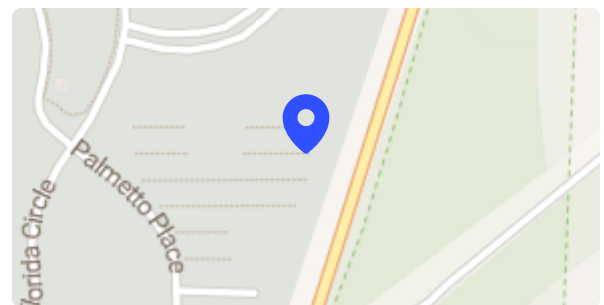
