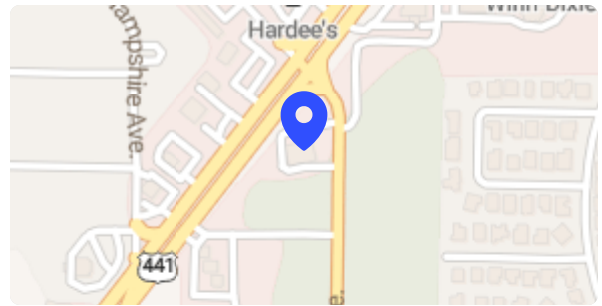

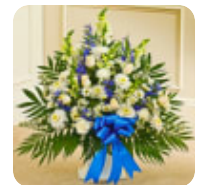
Resa posted:
