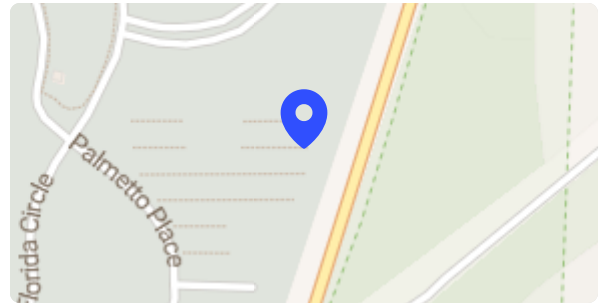

Joann & Glenn Carter posted:

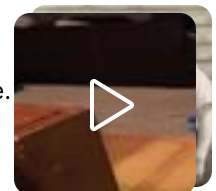
