William (Bill) L. Pinske, 68 passed away unexpectedly on Monday, August 5, 2019 at his home in Astatula, FL. Bill was born June 5, 1951, in Milwaukee, Wisconsin to Alfred and Shirley Pinske. Bill was a proud Vietnam Veteran of the United States Air Force, where he served as an aircraft electrical repair technician. He first served in Thailand at Korat Royal Air Force Base. Following his military service, he began a career as an Electronics Technician and worked in that field for multiple companies throughout Wisconsin until he retired in April 2014. 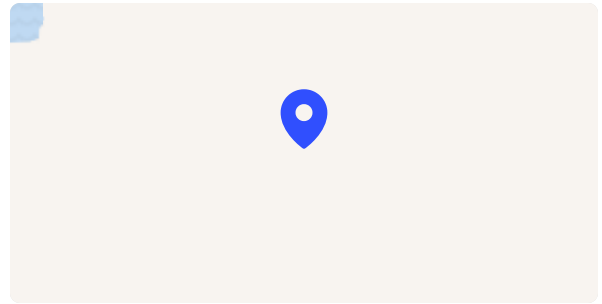

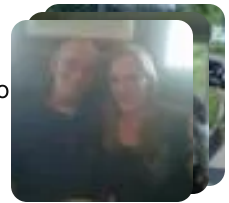
