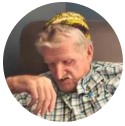
## **Mr. Robert Alvin Orie**

Robert and Mary were the owners of Orie Amoco Gas Station for many years. Robert also served his Country proudly in the United States Army. He was the only messenger assigned to deliver messages and correspondences in and out of the Nuremberg Trials at the end of World War II.

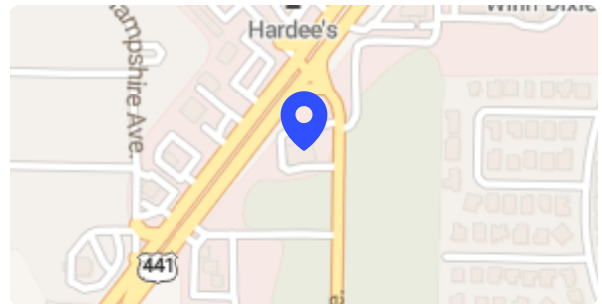

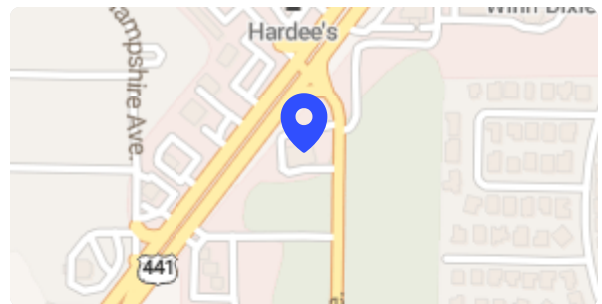

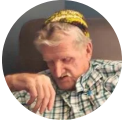
