Thomas Angelo Pasha passed away Thursday, February 24, 2011 at home in Howey-In-The-Hills. He was born February 12, 1930 in Detroit, Michigan. He is preceded in death by his parents, Edwin and Marian Pasha, Greenwich, Conn., and his brother William, Waterville, ME. Tom is survived by his wife of 58 years, Betty (Shea) Pasha, originally from Buffalo, NY, and the love of his life. He is survived by seven children; Marianne (John Mulry); Edwin (Kelly) Pasha; Thomas (Karen) Pasha; Peter, (Kathy) Pasha; Christopher (Debbie) Pasha; Liz Pasha; and Matthew (Suzanne) Pasha.
