Mr. Wilson C. Smith of Leesburg, Florida passed away on Friday, April 6, 2012 at the age of 93 years. He was born in Oconto, Wisconsin. Wilson proudly served his country in the US Army in WWII. He was a retired printer. He and his wife of 70 years, Marian, moved to this area 30 years ago from Jackson, Michigan. He was a member of St. Patrick Catholic Church in Mount Dora. Wilson was an accomplished musician, playing just about any instrument he picked up, and truly excelled at the guitar. He also enjoyed gardening. 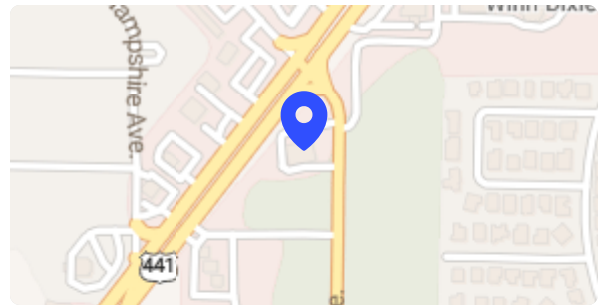

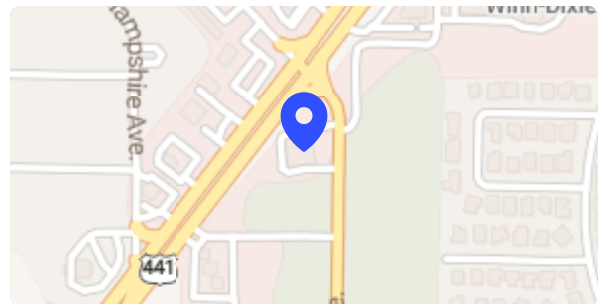

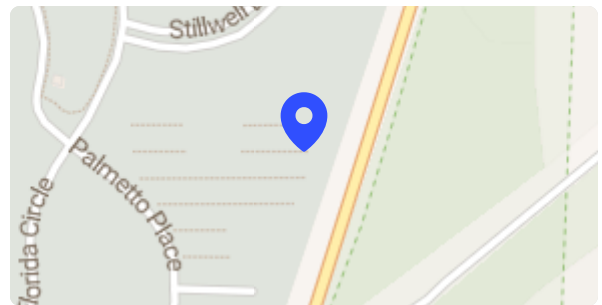
