Mr. Henry Dan Prewitt of Leesburg, Florida passed away on Monday, September 17, 2012 at the age of 83 years. He was born in Mount Sterling, Kentucky. He served his country in the US Army during World War II and the Koran Conflict. Dan also served in the US Air Force and later in the US Marine Corp Reserves. He met and married Stella and they spent 60 wonderful years together. Dan retired from NCR in Dayton Ohio as Director of Manufacturing after 33 years of service. He and Stella have been in Florida for 20 years, moving to Texas for a short period in between. Dan is a member of the Lake Square Presbyterian Church in Leesburg. He was past President of the Lakes of Leesburg and was a former Shriner and Mason. He was preceded in death by his sons, Joe and Jeff Prewitt.
