Mr. Felix Januszewski of Howey-in-the-Hills, Florida passed away on Tuesday, February 5, 2013 at the age of 93 years. He was born in Germany. Felix lived in France for many years. He served in the French Army in World War II. After the war he worked as a cabinet maker. He moved to the United States in 1951 settling in Milwaukee, Wisconsin and later moving to Necedah, Wisconsin. He worked in factory maintenance while living in Wisconsin. In the late 1970's he relocated to Howey-in-the-Hills, Florida. Felix was a wood craftsman and enjoyed making furniture and carvings. He liked to fix things around the house and tinker in the garage workshop. He is survived and will be dearly missed by his wife of 67 years, Irene; son, Raymond Januszewski and his wife, Kathy of Grand Island, Florida; daughter, Arlette and her husband John Hickman of Howey-in-the-Hills; sister, Irene Januszewski of Poland; granddaughter, Veronica and her husband, Jeff Hauke of La Crosse, Wisconsin and great granddaughter, Mackenzie. 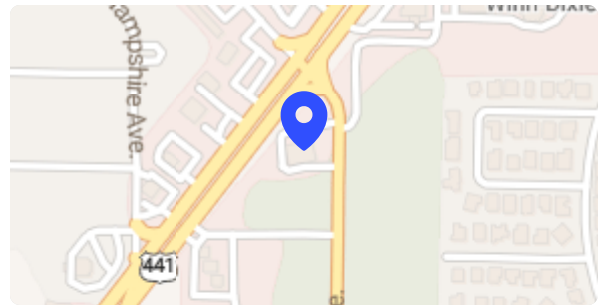
