Lorraine graduated from Hurst High School – and later earned her B.S. Degree from Geneva College in Beaver Falls, PA. She had a 28 year career in several responsible positions with a major Property and Casualty Insurance Company. She was a Claims Representative – promoted to Supervisory Positions in both Claims Handling and Training for Western PA. She was always a student and earned several professional designations throughout her career.

Lorraine had many interests – including travel, riding on motorcycle trips with her husband, snow skiing in the Laurel Mountains and she absolutely loved ballroom dancing.
